Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

Seminar Approvals/Accreditation

Our seminars are sponsored by SportsMedicine of Atlanta's APTA Credentialed Orthopaedic Manual Therapy Fellowship Program. This APTA Fellowship Program credentialing is performed yearly by the APTA. Seminars are recognized by the Physical Therapy Association's in Pennsylvania, Maryland, New Jersey, West Virginia and Ohio to meet licensure requirements for physical therapists. Seminars are also approved by the National Athletic Training Association's Board of Certification.

Seminar Availability

Eligibility

Physical therapists who are members or eligible for membership in the American Physical Therapy Association may attend the University's seminars. Specified seminars are open to occupational therapists, occupational therapist assistants, physical therapist assistants and athletic trainers.

Registration-Discount Policy

Team Discount - Two or more persons from the same facility, registering for the same seminar at the same time, receive a 10% discount at the time of registration. Advance notice and full payment required, does not apply after the 1st day of a seminar. Multiple Seminar Discount - Register and pay in full for two or more seminars at the same time and receive a 10% discount. May not be combined with any other discounts or previous registrations.

Seminar Fee Refund Policy

Cancellation up to five working days prior to the start of the seminar will result in 50% of the balance being refunded. Within five working days notice, no portion of the seminar fee will be refunded; however, the fee may be transferred to another seminar of the student's choosing or placed in a "funds on hold" account. Transfer of funds is limited to two seminars. After the seminar begins, no refunds are issued or transfer of funds permitted. If a student misses any portion of a seminar, a certificate of completion will not be issued until such portion is made up. A student can attend a subsequently scheduled seminar at no cost to make up the time and then receive his or her certificate upon successful completion. In the event of employer paid registrations, the employer has the right to cancel the registration under the above policy. The therapist will be contacted and may be given the option to remain registered for the seminar and become the responsible party for the fee.

Refunds shall be made within 30 days following the date SportsMedicine of Atlanta receives the student's cancellation request. Cancellations for the course may be made in writing by contacting the appropriate program administrative assistant at (770) 979-1400.

Tuition / Fees: Separate fees must be paid for library searches, transcripts, copies and other such services. All required seminar manuals are included in seminar fees. Recommended and required textbooks are available at an additional cost.
