4. One page essay on "My Reason for Being".
5. One page describing your past exposure to Orthopaedic Physical Therapy Practice. And an expressed interest in becoming an Orthopaedic Clinical Physical therapy Specialist.
6. List three (3) things you consider most wrong in Orthopaedic Physical Therapy and write one page on one of the factors you have listed, explaining why you feel it is wrong
7. List three (3) things you consider most right in Orthopaedic Physical Therapy and write one page on one of the factors you have listed, explaining why you feel it is right
8. One to two pages entitled "Where I Wish To Be In Five Years"
9. One page describing your preferred style of clinical learning, supervision and mentorship
