



Orthopaedic Residency Program

Orthopaedic Residency Successful Completion Criteria:

- 1) Satisfactorily Complete Application Process per defined Residency Application Criteria.
- 2) Satisfactorily Complete Curriculum: Orthopedic Section, APTA ISC 16.2 *Current Concepts of Orthopedic Physical Therapy*; satisfactorily passing each unit's mentor administered practical skill exam (80% competency based per defined criteria) and the Orthopedic Section graded ISC's Written Final Exam (80% passing score).
- 3) Attend and Satisfactorily Complete Four Onsite 12 hour Courses: (1) *Differential Diagnosis and Medical Screening*; (2) *Patient –Self-Referral in Action*; (3) *Clinical Biomechanics and Manual Therapy for the Lower Extremity and Lumbar Spine*; (4) *Clinical Biomechanics and Manual Therapy for the Upper Extremity, Cervical and Thoracic Spines*.
- 4) Score 80% on the "Direct Access Certification" on-line, written exam.
- 5) Score 80% on the "Medical Screening" competency-based practical exam.
- 6) Satisfactorily complete 150 hours of 1:1 mentoring within the 1500 hour program (with associated documentation of these hours including 80% satisfactory performance on practical competency-based exams).
